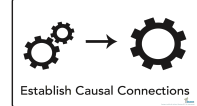

The Patriote party fought against British soldiers.

1871

The province of British Columbia is created

1867

The government in London passes the Canadian Constitution. The country has four provinces.

1840

Act of Union unites Upper and Lower Canada. The territory is now called the Province of United Canada.

1885

The railroad reaches British Columbia.

1873

Prince Edward Island joins Confederation.

1905

The provinces of Saskatchewan and Alberta are created.

1870

The province of Manitoba is created after numerous battles between the Métis and the British.
